VIII. New Business

A. SOTA Funding Request -Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding SOTA's Virtual Graduation Banquet.

She also encouraged The Commission to keep requesting funding since ASI has the budget to cover them. EOP Student Association asked what happens to funds not being used by clubs and orgs, and Quiller noted any additional funds will be reallocated towards the ASI General Budget.
