VII. Unfinished Business

A. Advisor's Advice Corner – Discussion Item

The Commission will review and address an overview of the Organizations Commission.

Quiller shared an Excel sheet that tracks all funding that clubs and orgs have requested and approved. The general budget has an ending balance of \$5,147 from funding requests. Therefore, she suggested for The Commission to submit funding requests for any future events they may have. Quiller noted any clubs and orgs highlighted on the sheet need to meet with her because they have not submitted a winner's form. Quiller reviewed budgets for promotional funding and student activities commission. She also discussed budget call and shared the 2020-2021 budget proposals to explain the procedure. She noted COVID-19 has made budget call a challenge when reallocating funds. Quiller mentioned clubs and orgs will be using Grub Hub meal credit when choosing food items on their proposals. Quiller shared an updated club points sheets and announced LSBA is in 1st place with 3,170 points, pre-OT in 2nd with 1,450 points, and pre-law in 3rd place with 970 points. A member from The Commission inquired about club points and Quiller shared the Club Point matrix sheet to explain. A member from The Commission asked what form they require for start up funds. Quiller noted they fill out a Partnership Program Request (PPR) form.

VIII. New Business

A. Human Resource Management Association – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding HRMA's Talk about Graduation Event.

Human Resource Management Association (HRMA) is requesting \$300 for graduation sashes being given at their Let's Talk about Graduation event. Their goal is to educate students on opportunities after post-graduation while congratulating seniors with graduation sashes. HRMA will have their event on April 26 at 5:00 PM. B. Human Resource Management Association – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding HRMA's 2nd General meeting of spring semester.

Human Resource Management Association (HRMA) is requesting \$100 for 4 \$25 gift cards. HRMA will be having a Second General Meeting event that would inform students of upcoming events and use gift cards to incentivize participation in their game. HRMA will have their second general meeting on April 5 at 5:00 PM. C. Human Services Student Association – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding HuSSA’s Black History Month Event.

Human Services Student Association (HuSSA) is requesting \$50 for 5 \$10 gift cards given at their Black History Cultural Event. The event’s goal is to give people the opportunity to join and share something that represents black history month. HuSSA will host their event on February 26 from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

Time for members of the audience to address the Commission.

Ibarra noted OSL is working alongside ASI and LSU to create a survey requiring student input on leadership at CSUDH. She urged students to check their emails to complete the survey to say whether they need additional support. Students can win up to \$50 in amazon gift cards. LSBA shared a synopsis about their last meeting held last week on February 17.

LSBA encouraged students to join if they are interested in listening to company speakers. They are also having a Panda Express fundraiser where clubs and orgs can support via coupon code. LSBA will be having a care package donation from February 15 - March 26 and Zen-it-out sessions with a mediation instructor on February from 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM. LSBA encouraged students to contact them if they need any help in raising funds or club points. Pre-law Society is having a Krispy Krème event where individuals can receive a %50 off discount when ordering a cart. They will also be having a Panda Express fundraiser on March 1 with coupon code. Pre-OT announced they are having a Panda Express fundraiser on February 28.
