VIII. New Business

A. Philosophy Club Funding Request – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding Philosophy Club's End of the Year Banquet.

Philosophy Club is requesting \$184 for Grub Hub credit to honor graduating seniors at their End of the Year event. They are requesting a reimbursement of \$84 for the graduation items they purchased for the event. The event will be held on May 28 at 4:00 p.m. and Vorobiev mentioned the event has been approved on Toro Link. Philosophy Club noted they will purchase 5 \$20 in Grub Hub credit for the event.

B. EOP Student Association Funding Request – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider EOP Association's End of the Year Celebration.

EOP Student Association is requesting \$375 for 15 \$25 gift cards to Target (5), Amazon (5), and Starbucks (5). Their End of the Year celebration will be held on May 17 from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM. The goal of their last workshop is to celebrate the academic success of students by playing games and socialization. Since Quiller notified EOPSA has only \$320 in their budget, EOPSA changed their request to \$320 towards 10 \$32 gift cards for Target and Starbucks. Quiller proceeded to make corrected adjustments to their PPR form. EOP Student Association encouraged clubs to contact them if they want to collaborate in their events.

C. ASI Organizations Commission Funding Request – Discussion/Action Item

The Commission will discuss and consider funding ASI Organizations Commission's End of the Year Celebration.

Quiller shared the updated Organizations General budget and showed there was \$2,400 remaining. Quiller asked if The Commission approves to have an End of the Year celebration; she also asked for ideas around planning the event. Many commission members stated they would like a *Game Night* event idea for the End of the Year celebration. Quiller mentioned clubs and orgs would oversee facilitating the games being played. EOPSA volunteered to facilitate the game Loteria; Quiller urged EOPSA to contact her on what materials and prizes they need. Quiller said she would send a registration form to all clubs and orgs so they

can RSVP for Grub Hub credit before the event. White stated the event would take place on June 11 after the Orgs meeting is adjourned.
