## VIII. New Business

### A. Club Points – Discussion Item

The Commission will discuss Club Point Policy, Matrix, & Submission.

Club Points are designed for clubs/organizations to get engaged on campus by attending or hosting events. However, due to COVID-19, the club points matrix has been adjusted to accommodate virtual zoom events and meetings.

The Club Points Sheet should be submitted via Toro Link or Social Media, no later than a week after the event. Organizations with the most club points will be awarded 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place.

### B. Budget Overview – Discussion Item

The Commission will review and discuss the General Organizations Commission Budget.

Quiller reviewed the General Organizations Commission Budget for the commission to understand the purpose of the budget. The Finance Commission sets aside money for student clubs, orgs, and university departments to assist with financial needs for student programming throughout the year. Quiller encouraged the commission to visit the ASI website and inquire into where the funds are being allocated. Quiller noted that any remaining funds at the end of the fiscal year revert back to the ASI general fund.

## IX. Reports

**University Rep: Norrbom** – Next week, the President will be hosting a Fall Convocation on September 15, 2020 via Zoom. This Fall's Convocation, the President will be opening a time capsule that was found on campus during construction. Norrbom mentioned that there are CSUDH offices that are still hiring student assistants and that the job positions can be found on *Handshake*. She also noted that a variety of OSL offices from different universities will be getting together to host the Inaugural California Student Leadership Conference on Friday, October 16 and Saturday, October 17. The conference theme is "Rise Up" in hopes to

strengthen and transform students to a change agent on campus and within the community

**OSL Rep: Ibarra** - Ibarra recapped on the Involvement fair that OSL hosted September 3. Ibarra mentioned that if clubs and orgs were not able to attend, there will be information sessions for students to engage on a virtual space. The deadline for a club/org to be recognized is on September 11 but Ibarra announced that another opportunity will be given to the club/orgs who are missing one final item. OSL will have open hours on zoom for anybody to join in and acquire any information they need; the zoom link will be on Toro link.

**PPEC-** announced that an event hosted by PPEC and co-hosted by the Title IX office will be taking place on September 10 at 4-5 pm. This event will inform participants about the new Title IX regulations that have gone into effect. This event will also provide students a space where they can ask questions in a form of Q&A.

EOPSA asked if club points will be awarded to each person in the org that attends an event and Quiller mentioned that club points will only be awarded if the club/org is present, regardless how many people from that club show up.
