IX. New Business

A. End of the Year Budget – Discussion Item

The Commission will review the end of the year budget for 2020-2021. Quiller informed the Commission that over \$15,000 was deposit and over \$18,000 paid out from club account transactions. Orgs commission allocated over \$4,500 in funds towards 41 events, and \$650 in promo items / startup funds. Quiller also reminded the Commission of the amended Gift Card Policy established to offer new incentives to encourage student participation and engagement to ASI sponsored programs, activities, and/or events during the pandemic. Over \$1,800 went towards gift cards incentives. Individual clubs/orgs collected over \$11,350 through ASI's corporate PayPal account, and over 400 meal credits were given out via ASI's GrubHub corporate account. Ibarra asked if gift cards would still be available during the fall semester and Quiller answered that the gift card policy has some adjustments and will be available while the campus is still operating virtually.

B. Club Point Winners – Discussion Item

The Commission will hear announcement of ASI Club Point winners. Quiller announced the ASI Club Point Winners are LSBA in 1<sup>st</sup> place, Pre-Law Society in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and Pre-Occupational Therapy Club in 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Quiller mentioned club points can be earned when clubs and orgs participate in different events, town halls, or other university activities; they can tag ASI on social media accounts to gain points.

X. Open Forum – Discussion Item

Time for members of the audience to address the Commission. Ibarra mentioned OSL has used student feedback to change their recognition process and make it easier for club and orgs registrations. Ibarra shared a link for clubs and organizations to identify their new officers chosen after elections so OSL can send them an email. Quiller noted June 30<sup>th</sup> is the final day that approved funds will be available; she urged all clubs to send any winner's forms and participants lists to her. Quiller thanked Ibarra and Vorobiev for their continuous help and support, and thanked Yoara Cruz, Front Desk Assistant, for her help in transcribing the meeting's minutes. Vorobiev mentioned OSL is planning to reinstate the in-person lead retreat that will provide leadership workshops and training to club and org student leaders. She mentioned an email will be sent out to collect feedback on returning to campus. All participants were encouraged to stay after adjournment to socialize.
