The Associated Students, Inc. conducted their annual General Elections from March 24-27, 2025. Elections were held online with the Elections Commission monitoring the campaign practices. The online elections and the official ballot count were managed by Election Buddy Online Voting Services and Software. Based on an electronic count of the ballots cast over the four-day election period, the following results were noted:
